

2012 Voter Registration Drive and Teaching Biblical Principles

Dear Pastor / Church Leader –

America is facing the loss of its religious freedom – a fundamental inalienable right given to us by God. The Bible teaches we must be diligent in choosing our government officials. It also teaches principles & rules we are to live by and follow. For example, it is very clear on the issues of abortion, homosexuality and marriage. The Church is supposed to uphold those values, i.e. the Biblical World View, not the Secular World View. Those issues are NOT the purview of the government. Freedom of Religion constrains us to speak forth the truth of God's Word and the government should not violate that freedom by regulating our practice of it. We therefore should be – have to be – bold enough to defend it. ***See enclosed information on legal aspects of getting involved "For Pastors" and "For Churches".***

One of the important items not reported is that national statistics indicate on average only 30% of church goers are registered to vote, and less actually vote. It is no wonder that people of all faiths are under attack in this country?

Our Church can help combat these attacks. Here's how – As a minimum, I am asking your permission to have a non-partisan registration drive during the months of August & September here in our Church. Ideally a notice would be placed in the bulletin telling the members that the registration forms will be available in the church office until the election is over. Perhaps we can setup manned tables for after-service registration of a few select Sundays. An announcement to that effect from the pulpit would be very encouraging to all as well. I would gladly draft the message for the bulletin and help in any way possible to make this run smoothly.

I've also included a 6 min. video put together by the Family Research Council that talks about the importance of teaching biblical principles as they relate to the election of our government officials. After viewing it, please feel free to contact me with any questions and/or assistance I can provide.

Many people are not sure if they are actually registered or not. For example, young people who have recently turned 18 or have moved from one area to another, but their polling places have changed. And there are many others who have not paid attention to politics for years. We all need to be alert and awake for this most important/critical election on Nov. 6th. We all have a God given right to choose our leaders. I would like to help them make that happen.
